

Transferring Domains Away from RDB-uk.

To prevent your Internet Domain being misused or 'stolen' the domain naming authorities have various security methods to ensure your domain details can only be updated by your current Internet Provider.

Therefore, transferring your domain to another ISP involves a set procedure that must be adhered to in order for your new Internet Provider to be recognized by the naming authorities.

If you decide to move to another provider, we will not close your account until your new Internet Provider has taken control of your domain. To ensure you receive mail, your domain will continue to be controlled by our name servers and your accounts will remain active on our network until the transfer is complete. We will process the change quickly so that you do not incur unnecessary charges.

PLEASE NOTE: As soon as your domain has been transferred from RDB-uk it will no longer be attached to accounts you still have with us. Email sent to this domain will now arrive at your alternative provider.

We will not act upon any requests for transferring a domain away from RDB-uk until we receive this form attached to your company headed paper to prevent the possibility of a fraudulent request.
